Thank you all for providing an incredible learning environment that has laid a strong foundation for my journey in social work.

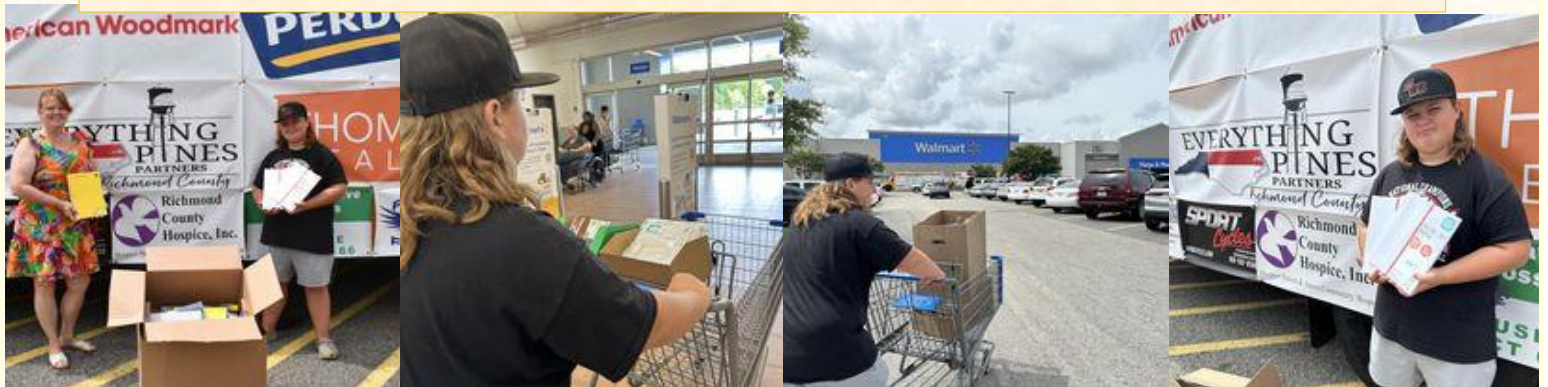

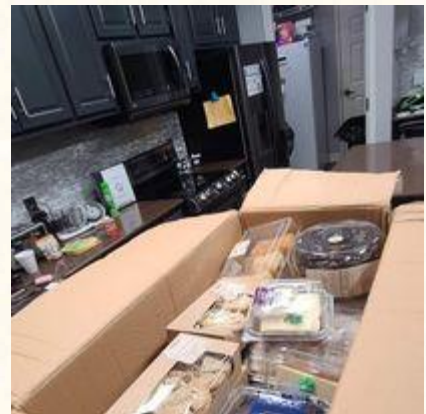

The CHAPLAIN'S Corner

THE LORD WILL GIVE
STRENGTH UNTO HIS PEOPLE;
THE LORD WILL BLESS HIS
PEOPLE WITH PEACE.

PSALMS 29:11 KJV

Peace can be an elusive concept. It is defined as tranquility or an absence of strife. When I seek peace, I often look in God's creation, kayaking on a placid lake, hiking in a green forest. But an absence of peace can occur at any moment. It may be the middle of the night, the middle of a meeting, or the middle of a commute.
