Our Purpose:

The purpose of Richmond County Hospice is to provide compassionate care and support to individuals who are in the final stages of a terminal illness – when curative treatment is no longer being pursued – and to ensure they can live as fully and comfortably as possible in their remaining time.

Our Focus:

Comfort over cure: Managing pain and symptoms to improve quality of life rather than attempting to treat the disease.

Emotional and spiritual support: For both the patient and their family, often provided by chaplains, bereavement counselors and social workers.

Family-centered care: Involving family in care decisions and offering them respite, guidance, and support.

At-home care or hospice facilities: Care is often provided in the patient's home, but can also take place in hospice centers, nursing homes, or hospitals.

Team approach: Hospice usually involves a team of healthcare professionals (nurses, doctors, aides, social workers, chaplains, & volunteers) working together.

The goal is to bring dignity, peace, and as much comfort as possible during the final phase of life.



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Why is it important to fundraise and receive charitable donations for our non-profit hospice?

Fundraising and charitable donations play a critical role in sustaining the mission and operations of nonprofit hospices. These contributions directly impact the quality of care, accessibility of services, and long-term viability of the organization.

The following outline the key reasons why philanthropic support is essential:

1. Bridging Financial Gaps in Patient Care

While hospice services are often reimbursed by Medicare, Medicaid, and private insurance, these funding sources do not always cover the full scope of care needed. In addition, donations ensure that all individuals—regardless of their financial situation—can receive compassionate, end-of-life care without compromise.

2. Supporting Comprehensive, Holistic Services

Nonprofit hospices frequently offer services that extend beyond basic medical care. These may include bereavement counseling, spiritual support, volunteer programs, and complementary therapies such as music, massage, or pet therapy. Such programs, while invaluable to patients and families, are typically not covered by insurance and rely heavily on philanthropic support.

3. Preserving Mission-Driven Integrity

As nonprofit organizations, hospices prioritize patient comfort, dignity, and quality of life over profit. Fundraising enables us to remain community-focused and uphold high standards of care without being influenced by financial incentives or shareholder demands.

4. Enhancing Facilities and Medical Resources

Charitable contributions help fund the purchase of medical equipment, the maintenance of hospice facilities, and the creation of comforting environments for patients. These investments are essential to ensuring that patients receive care in safe, peaceful, and well-equipped settings.

5. Ensuring Organizational Sustainability

Reliable donor support allows nonprofit hospices to plan for the future, retain skilled healthcare professionals, and adapt to changes in healthcare policy or funding. It provides a stable foundation from which the organization can continue to serve the community for years to come.

This year, we will be celebrating our 40th anniversary in providing hospice care to our community. Our prayer will be to continue our mission in our community for 40 plus more years to come.
