What is the name of a good movie you've enjoyed watching so much you would watch it over again? *Twister, if I wasn't a nurse I'd be a storm chaser.*

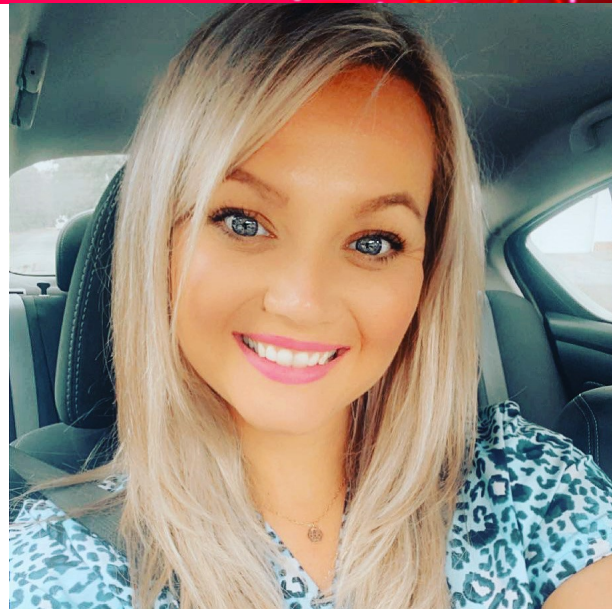
Tell us the top three highlights of your life? *The day I married my husband, the day each of my children were born, and the day I finished nursing school.*
